# STEP FIVE

Interface meeting between communities and duty bearers

# **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Priority list of service delivery issues discussed by PBCs, community members and duty bearers
- Commitments to address service delivery gaps solicited
- A follow up plan developed for the commitments made

### **OUTPUT**:

- Commitments secured from duty bearers to address service delivery gaps
- Feedback provided on service delivery gaps addressed by duty bearers

# STEP FOUR

Consensus building and feedback meetings

# **REQUIREMENTS:**

- PBC budget monitoring and service delivery tracking report discussed at community dialogues
- Priority list of key service delivery issues discussed and agreed on by PBCs adn wider community

### **OUTPUT**:

- Budget monitoring report validated at the meeting
- Priority list developed by PBCs and wider community

# STEP THREE

Monitoring budget implementation and monitoring and service delivery

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- A monitoring plan developed by PBCs
- Mapping of Government aided facilities/ programs by PBCs
- Periodical visits to Government aided facilities/ programs conducted to generate evidence on state of service delivery.

### **OUTPUT:**

- Periodical budget monitoring and service delivery tracking report generated by PBCs

# STEP ONE

Organizing and mobilising communities into Participator Budget Clubs (PBCs)

# **REQUIREMENTS: -**

- -Meeting duty bearers to:
  - -Introduce program to duty bearers in the area.
  - -Identify areas of operation within the district.
- -Meeting common members to:
  - -Select memebers to join PBCs composed of 20-30 individuals (30%) of them being women, youth and PWDs must be represented

### **OUTPUT:**

- Duty bearers and citizens aware and agree to support PBC work.
- Geographic areas of operation agreed on.
- -PBC members identified and PBC Executive committees elected.

# STEP TWO

Capacity strengthening of PBCs in community budget monitoring and Service delivery tracking (CBMSDT)

# **REQUIREMENTS:**

- -Identification of community based facilitators (CBFs)
- CBFs trained in key training techniques of CBMSDT
- CBFs conduct trainings for PBCs guided by a training plan

### **OUTPUT:**

- -CBFs identified and trained in training techniques of CBMSDT
- -CBFs undertake capacity building trainings for PBCs
